The aim of exploratory stage was to explore intrinsic value centers and evaluation criteria among studied population. The results of exploratory stage showed that the conceptual structures of intrinsic value and evaluation criterion are complex. The structure of intrinsic value concept includes three elements of anthropocentric, ecocentric and theocentric. The main objective of the confirmatory stage was to test the defined theory obtained in the exploratory stage. It is supported by empirical evidence using facet theory that two concepts of intrinsic value and evaluation criterion were precisely defined in exploratory stage. This research introduced a new approach called EgoEcology which emphasizes human's inner self to conserve the natural environment through self-definition and inner self-defence.
